

ASSESSORS

The practical assessors role is to evaluate candidates performance during their practical assessment. Assessors will grade each candidate using a set criteria issued by IWCF.

Assessors are required for Drilling Well Control level 3 and 4.

REQUIREMENTS



It is mandatory for applicants to hold a current level 4 certification in our Drilling Well Control programme. A minimum of 90% in each of the assessments must be achieved.

Applicants must also meet one of the following requirements:



A minimum of 2 years field experience in a supervisory role. For Drilling Well Control, experience as a Driller, Toolpusher or Wellsite Engineer is required.



A Bachelor of Science degree in a relevant subject and at least one year field experience in a role which requires a current IWCF level 3 or level 4 certificate.



A relevant vocational qualification and at least one year field experience in a role which requires a current IWCF level 3 or level 4 certificate.

ASSESSOR TRAINING

All assessors must attend the IWCF Assessor course as part of their accreditation:

Our Assessor course is designed to ensure assessors are competent and confident in their ability to assess practical assessments, and ensure all candidates receive a consistently high global standard of assessment.

The assessor course is mandatory for all new assessors . Costs are £1,800 / €2,160 / \$2,700
